Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on the 10 November 2016
in Egloskerry Village Hall at 19.30 hours.

The Minutes of the Meetings held on 14 July 2016 & 8 September 2016
were duly approved and signed by the Vice Chairman as a correct record.

Matters Arising from the Minutes:

- (1) Repairs, excluding the slide, completed in the Play Area by ~~Mr J S~~ T Wilton. Quote to follow to repair the slide.
- (2) Donation to Churchyard fund discussed; letter received from Mr J ~~S~~ on behalf of Egloskerry Parochial Church Council. Concern raised whether money would be spent on Egloskerry Churchyard or go into a general fund. Councillor Francis to enquire at next Church Council meeting. Matter deferred until next meeting.
- (3) Further to Planning Application:- PA16/04842 – Hilly's Barn, Badharlick - Proposed rear and side extension with cellar – Application objected to by the Parish Council. A letter has been received from Cornwall Planning Service advising the Parish Council that an appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the Council's decision. There is no opportunity for the Parish Council to submit further comments.

Any Other Business:

(1) Hedge trimming has been carried out in the Play Area by Chris Emmett, as requested by the Parish Council. Unfortunately due to the wet weather conditions this has caused deep rutting, which may have been avoided if done earlier. However, Mrs ~~Hilly~~, whose property borders onto the Play Area, phoned the Vice Chairman expressing her thanks that the hedge is nicely trimmed.

(2) Complaints received regarding missing cats eyes along the road between the Village and Launceston; the haphazard positioning of the remaining ones is considered to be a danger to motorists. Clerk to email Councillor Paynter and Oliver Jones.

(3) Results of the speed visor circulated to the Councillors. Due to the obvious speeding taking place, Oliver Jones advised writing to the Neighbourhood Beat Manager requesting some enforcement. Deferred until results have been looked at.

(4) Clerk received an email from ~~Diana Lacey~~ – Waste & Environmental Contract Officer of Cornwall Council advising that a female resident of Egloskerry was very concerned that the bin in the Play Area was overflowing about three weeks prior, and was not being emptied on a regular basis.

Clerk confirmed that the responsibility of the bin was that of the Parish Council and that it was emptied when necessary and had never overflowed. It had been quite full at the time in question but was then emptied. Clerk added that the resident was more than welcome to join the small number of community minded volunteers who empty the bin when necessary, replacing the lining bag each time.

(5) Clerk asked if Parish Councillors could let her know by the Monday prior to the Meeting if they are unable to attend to facilitate re-scheduling, if necessary. Clerk's contact details to be printed/emailed to all Councillors.
