The Minutes of the Meeting held on 17 December 2020 were formally and duly approved by the Chairman as a correct record.

Matters Arising from the Minutes:

Following the objection raised on the 4 December 2020, Cornwall Council's Planning Department supported the application and asked the Parish Council to reconsider and (1) agree with their recommendation, or (2) agree to disagree or (3) maintain original decision and request the application be determined by the Planning Committee.

Option 3 was chosen based on the following:-

"In respect of design and materials, it is appreciated that 'a poor pastiche of traditional buildings is not to be encouraged', but the statement that 'the use of other modern materials is considered to allow it to be read as a building of its time within an existing settlement' is interesting and the end result, the inappropriate character of this new build, is precisely why the Parish Council objected to the application.

Disappointingly the application was not escalated to the Planning Committee and therefore it was considered unreasonable to make any other decision than that of approval. Decision emailed to Parish Councillors.

#### 4. *Pleasure Ground (small field situated in Badharlick) -*

Email received from the Charity Commission on the 21 January 2021 having been informed that the Parish Council had involvement, but not having a record of the resignation of the trustee. Clerk telephoned the trustee for copies of paperwork, but nothing forthcoming. Clerk to write to obtain information for discussion at the next meeting.

Further to contact from residents regarding dog fouling in the village opposite the school and in the churchyard, 'No dogs allowed' signs, made by a resident, have been fixed to the three Church gates, the cost to be shared equally between the Parish Council and the Church Council. Clerk also looked into the possibility of obtaining another dog waste bin from Cornwall Council, however, none available due to cost of installing & servicing.
