Pleasure Ground – It was decided to go ahead with seeking advice on this matter.

Playing Field –

P Burden was thanked for all his work supporting the new equipment installation team. Works have been completed this week. Two invoices have been paid from the lottery grant, the last three will now be paid. The total is as per the quote.

A Community fund plaque has been fixed to the new equipment. National Lottery is keen to receive all feedback. H Young has drafted a notice for the Parish Magazine and Fb Residents page, about the new equipment and asking for feedback and suggestions. Responses received so far have been very positive.

The Rospa play safety inspection will take place in April.

The football goals had been moved but have now been put back in place and new nets have been fitted. The ground anchors are missing, Clerk to see if Broxap have them otherwise will need replacements.
