Matters Arising from the Minutes:

3. Planning applications -
 - (a) PA21/01959 - Hillies Barn, Badharlick - Proposed double car port. Application amended. Revised design now using duo-pitched slate roof with weatherboarded sides. Proposed siting moved away from the hedge removing the necessity for concrete retaining panels. Revised Application supported and emailed to the Planning Department.

(b) PA21/04018 - Old Mill, Badharlick - Proposed conversion of Mill Barn to domestic residential and holiday letting. Application not supported on the following basis:-

Given that this application is to convert this barn to domestic residential and holiday letting, it is disappointing that some of the details proposed are so alien to the local vernacular. The existing roof is a mix of slate tiles and corrugated metal, but it is intended to replace this with the latter when local slates would surely be more appropriate both to the building itself and to the intended re-purpose of it as a dwelling. The other details which give cause for concern are the new dormer clad with black rubber, and the new and huge double glazed windows at the gable end. None of the windows have any glazing bars, all of which are out of character with the existing building and the rural setting.
