Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on
Thursday 22nd September 2022 at 19.30 hours in the Village Hall

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 14th July 2022 were formally and duly approved by the Chairman as a correct record.

Councillor A Paynter attended before the meeting and updated those present on matters regarding **Launceston Medical Centre**. The LMC manager had had a lot of complaints and since then things were starting to improve regarding booking appointments and dealings with the pharmacy.

The **Pleasure Ground** was also discussed and it was decided that the Clerk should contact Martin Wright at Cornwall Council for any further information he can give on the Pleasure Ground registration, and advice on how to go about registration.

Matters Arising from the Minutes:

Playing field - Signage - A. Uren will be putting the signs asking for dogs to be kept on a lead.

The sign on the playing field gate is breaking up. Clerk has a quote from Tavistock Signs for 1 x 800mm x 630mm aluminium sign, digitally printed and laminated for £60 + Vat, and fitting for £40 + vat. It was agreed to go ahead and order and pay from the Turbary account.

Playing Field Annual inspection repairs – C Peerless has volunteered to do the repairs but has been too busy all summer, nothing has been done yet, ongoing.

SeeSaw replacement – Clerk had quotes from two suppliers to replace and install a new see saw. It was agreed to go with Play Outdoors. Clerk and H Young to place order for see saw and two picnic tables.

Dog control. Clerk had contacted Cornwall Council who supplied more signs that have been put up.

Dog bin – James has resigned from emptying the park waste bin. A local resident has volunteered to do it. It was agreed to monitor the situation for further discussion at the next meeting.

Hedge trimming – is due again, Clerk to contact Roger Gillbard and ask him to do the playing field hedge trimming again.

Defibrillator training will be planned for next year in June, the Parish Council will pay for it. It needs to be advertised on all notice boards and in the parish magazine.

Planning applications. PA22/08058 Proposal Prior notification of proposed development by telecommunications operators for the upgrade of an existing base station, removal and replacement of one 17.5 metre monopole for a proposed 20 metres monopole supporting 3 antennas, two 0.3 m dishes, relocation of existing apparatus to the proposed tower, installation of two cabinets. Location T Mobile Communications Mast Tregear Road Egloskerry Launceston. Applicant Cellnex, EE Ltd and Hutchinson 3G. No objections from those present.

Speeding in the village. The mobile vehicle activated sign (MVAS) was redeployed in Egloskerry in August and Clerk has requested the data. The flashing speed sign in Tregadillet was thought to be good and popular, Clerk to contact T Jones at Tregadillet to ask about it.

Bus Shelter – Clerk has two quotes, the quote from Mat Brimacombe was accepted, clerk to phone and arrange.

Pleasure Ground. F. Colville was absent but had forwarded research notes. The matter was discussed with Councillor A Paynter, see notes above.

Tregear Green. The grass has been selectively trimmed by Mr Horsey. Matter ongoing.

Tree for the Jubilee. Clerk had contacted Cornwall Council about planting on the grass triangle at the bottom of the Badharlick Hill. A planting licence would need to be applied for, with details of tree, root barrier etc. Jamie from Langore Tree Services has offered to help plant etc. Clerk to apply for planting licence.

Old Railway Bridge. Clerk to contact Chris Monk at Cormac again to see if they have contacted the landowners about removing weeds from the bridge.
